Memorandum from the Political and Reforms Department No. 1955/34, dated the 5th January 1938 :—

"The attention of the Departments of the Secretariat is invited to the provisions of section 262 (2) of the Government of India Act, 1935, read with paragraph 15 (1) of the Government of India (Commencement and Transitory Provisions) Order, 1936, and they are requested to supply this Department by the 25th January 1938 at the latest with a list of Indian States, tribal areas or territories adjacent to India, any subjects or natives of which were serving in connection with the affairs of this Province on the 1st April 1937.

This list which should be absolutely correct, complete and exhaustive, should relate to all offices (including the High Court) under the administrative control of the several Departments and include the names of all the States, tribal areas or territories adjacent to India, any subjects or natives of which are in service under the rule-making control of the Provincial Government, including holders of listed posts in the Indian Civil Service. Each Department should, so far as it and offices subordinate to it are concerned, send a consolidated list from which all duplicate entries should be omitted.

It is stated for the information of the Departments and officers subordinate to them that 'tribal area' includes such territory as trans-frontier territory or Nepal and that 'territory adjacent to India' includes such territory as Portuguese India.

The omission of any State, tribal area or territory adjacent to India, a native of which is serving in any Department, from the list would mean that it would not be included in any declaration under section 262 and thereby the Government official concerned would automatically be debarred from remaining in service after 31st March 1938.

A list* of the old Bombay States is enclosed for the information of the Departments and the officers subordinate to them, but it is recognised that in certain Departments number of officers may have been recruited from States not included in this list."

RESOLUTION.—Copies of the foregoing memorandum should be forwarded to the officers concerned, and they should be requested to furnish Government in the Home Department immediately with the information called for therein.
